Completion of Irrigation Project initiated in 2020 and Rehab of Ponds, 2021





The purpose was to: (1) get fill dirt to fill-in the ditch created in 2020 on the south side of the ponds (noted in red); (2) to remove the berm around the pond (noted in yellow) and create a more natural appearing habitat (rather than a square pond); (3) the square pond is full of dirt and is filled-in with 3' in mud. The pond needs to be rehabilitated since it was built back in the 1940-50s; (4) create a 5 acre pond.
